Please encourage your parents to come and complete the
FAFSA**

1. Finalize your **college applications**
2. Check the **website of the college you plan to attend** for scholarship and financial aid deadlines
3. Complete **scholarship applications** on the **Senior Newsletter**
4. Take **ACT/SAT** if required
5. Complete the **ACCUPLACER** testing if planning to attend a 2 year college or technical school. You should take the test in January or February. See Mrs. Locke for information
6. Complete the **FAFSA** (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)
 - Both parent AND student need an **FSA ID** to complete the FAFSA (You must complete this first)
